TRANSPORT BOOKING FORM

Your signature on the booking form confirms you accept these Terms and Conditions as a binding contract between AMS Motorcycles and you, the participant.

RESERVATION AND DEPOSIT

Your deposit of £100 per bike should be made payable to AMS Motorcycles (50% of costs if less than 30 days of transport) a receipt will be issued by return.

PAYMENT OF BALANCE

We will send you a Booking Confirmation and Invoice, which must be paid prior to travel.

INSURANCE

Clients must take out trip cancellation insurance. (AA Five Star travel insurance or similar).

PRICE OF TRANSPORT INCLUDES

Please see accompanying itinerary.

TOUR RATES

Prices quoted on the AMS Motorcycles websites www.AMSMotorcycles.org.uk and www.amstours.org.uk are those in effect at time of publishing. If cost factors, including but not limited to hotels, meals, motorcycle, insurance, international currency fluctuations etc dictate the need for fare increases.

AMS Motorcycles may do so at any time prior to 60 days before departure.

PRICE OF TOUR DOES NOT INCLUDE

Our website www.AMSMotorcycles.org.uk and www.amstours.org.uk lists the items not included in our tour price. Specifically Flights and all items of a personal nature are also not included.

BIKE RESTRICTIONS

AMS Motorcycles will only accept motorcycles that have not been modified from original manufacture unless written acceptance is received from AMS Motorcycles.

CANCELLATION CHARGES

Cancellations received more than 60 days prior to tour start date will be subject to a £100 per person cancellation fee. Cancellations received less than 60 days prior to tour start date will be subject to the following forfeit of tour cost; 59 – 42 days, 40% of tour cost; 41 – 21 days, 50% of tour cost; within 20 days, 100% of tour cost. No exception to this policy can be made for any reason.

MINIMUM PARTICIPANTS

Up to 30 days prior to tour start date, AMS Motorcycles reserve the right to cancel a tour if insufficient numbers of participants have booked and fully paid. In this event, AMS Motorcycles will offer to operate the tour if all customers agree to a supplementary charge. If this is not acceptable to all customers, a full refund will be made of all monies paid, which will constitute the full settlement. AMS Motorcycles is not liable for any additional costs or losses incurred by the tour participant. This includes, but is not limited to, the cost of pre-paid airline tickets, hotel reservations and vehicle rentals.

CANCELLATION

AMS Motorcycles reserve the right in any circumstances to cancel your booking, giving you six weeks notification (except in circumstances beyond our control) and a full refund of all monies paid, which will constitute the full settlement. AMS Motorcycles is not liable for any additional costs or losses incurred by the tour participant. This includes, but is not limited to, the cost of pre-paid airline tickets, hotel reservations and vehicle rentals.

TOUR ALTERATIONS

AMS Motorcycles tours operate on a seasonal basis. Where seasonal variances and/or weather conditions cause changes to the tour route or accommodation, alternative routes and hotels will be used.

AMS Motorcycles is responsible for providing the services listed in the itinerary description according to the local standard and the accurate description of services offered in its literature. AMS Motorcycles is responsible for conscientious travel preparations. AMS Motorcycles is not responsible or liable for any accidents. Furthermore, it is agreed and understood that the owners, operators and agents of this transport including AMS Motorcycles are not the guardians of any customer's safety and they, individually or collectively cannot be held liable in any way for any occurrence in connection with the operation or the client's participation in connection with the tour, which might result in injury, death or other damage to the client, his property, or his family, heirs, or assigns. AMS Motorcycles is not responsible or liable for a delay occurring from the ferry or airline operator's failure to adhere to published timetables.

TRANSFER OF BOOKING

Participants may transfer the booking to another person providing that a minimum of two weeks notice is given. Amendments to the original booking may be subject to a £25 administration charge.

WEATHER CONDITIONS

Tours pass through areas where weather conditions can change rapidly. AMS Motorcycles cannot be made liable for unpleasant or unsuitable weather conditions, and no refunds are made for such conditions.

DRIVING LICENCE AND VEHICLE DOCUMENTS

Riders need only have a current driving licence from their country of origin and valid vehicle documentation and insurance. These documents should be carried at all times.

HEALTH FORMALITIES

UK Tour participants should apply for form E111 issued by the Post Office, which entitles the holder to urgent treatment for accident or unexpected illness in EU countries. Participants are strongly advised to take out additional travel insurance to cover against any expenses not covered by form E111.

FORCE MAJEURE AND COMPENSATION

Compensation payments or refunds will not be made in the following situations:

War, threat of war, riots, civil strife, terrorist activity, industrial disputes, natural disasters, fire, technical problems to transport, closure or congestion of ports, cancellations or changes to schedules by carriers ceasing to operate due to adverse weather conditions or other reasons and similar events beyond our control or where we cancel because you fail to pay the balance of your holiday cost.

COMPLAINTS PROCEDURE

Complaints should be put in writing within one month of return.

VERBAL CHANGES

Verbal changes of contract are invalid unless confirmed in writing by AMS Motorcycles.

ERRORS AND OMISSIONS

AMS Motorcycles reserves the right to correct errors or calculation mistakes at any time.
